President of the inaugural function Hon. Prin. Dr. Deepti Deshpande, focused on significance of National Handloom Day and selection of khadi theme for exhibition. She gave blessings and congratulated the entire team for such a novel initiative.</p> <p>The exhibition display was inaugurated at the hands of Chief Guest Mrs. Gargi Bhandari.</p> <p>Textile Science and Apparel Design department put various stalls with actual demonstration on spinning and weaving. Models of manufacturing process of khadi, spinning with amber charkha were displayed.</p> <p>They also created awareness by wearing hand stitched contemporarized khadi apparels. Students prepared fashion apparels, table mats, tea coasters from marigold (natural dye) promoting sustainable apparels and home textiles.</p>


