Brief summary	<p>The Three-Day Online Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights was organized from 13th March 2023 to 15th March 2023 by Internal Quality Assurance Cell in collaboration with Department of Management Studies & Entrepreneur. The event was organized with an aim to provide a comprehensive understanding of intellectual property rights and their significance in today's world.</p> <p>The first day started with an introductory address by Mrs. Maithili Lakhe, who welcomed the audience and introduced the resource person for the day, Prof. Dr. Mrs. Manjusha Kulkarni I/C Principal, RNC Arts, JDB Commerce & NSC Science College, Nashik Road. The discourse of Prof. Dr. Mrs. Manjusha Kulkarni was on the topic "Types of Intellectual Property." Prof. Kulkarni provided an overview of the different types of intellectual property rights, including patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets. She explained the key features of each type of intellectual property right, their scope, and the process for obtaining them. Prof. Kulkarni also provided real-life examples of intellectual property rights violations and explained the legal recourse available to the affected parties. She emphasized the need for individuals and businesses to be aware of their intellectual property rights and to take appropriate measures to protect them. infringement, trademark registration, and copyright violations.


The first day concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Yashwant Kelkar.



The Second day concluded with a vote of thanks by Mrs. Maithili Lakhe.





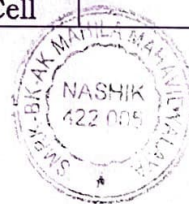
