Eligibility :

- 1. Financial assistance will be available to Indian students with at least 40% disabilities certified as per definition under persons with disabilities Act 1995.
- 2. Financial assistance will be given for pursuing post-Matric/Post-Secondary technical and professional courses including Ph.D. & M.Phil from recognized Instutitions. However, for students with disabilities of Cerebal Palsy, Mental Retardation, Multiple Disabilities, and profound or Severe Hearing Impaired, the minimum educational qualification will be VIII pass and Scholarships will be awarded to them for pursuing general, technical, vocational or professional courses.
- 3. Scholarship will be awarded to one student for pursuing only one course.
- 4. Financial assistance can be given for computer with editing software for blind / deaf graduate and postgraduate students pursuing professional courses and for support access software for cerebral palsied students.

- 7. A scholarship holder under this scheme will not concurrently hold any other scholarship / stipend. If already any other scholarahip / stipend awarded, the student is required to exercise his / her option for choosing the scholarship that he/she proposes to avail and inform awarding authority about the same.
- 8. Monthly family income of the beneficiary should not be more than Rs. 15,000/- from all sources, family income includes income of the parent / guardian.







The National Education Policy (NEP2020) which is being implemented by the Govt., is the new face of education in India. Under this Policy, a student can adopt a multi-disciplinary bachelor's degree in an undergraduate programme with multiple exit options. The students can undertake professional and vocational areas. The student can get:

- A certificate after completing One year of study/programme
- A Diploma after completing Two years of study/programme
- A Bachelors degree after completing Three of study/programme
- A Multidisciplinary Bachelors degree after completing Four years of the study/ programme
- A Bachelors (Hon) degree after completing Five years of the study/programme. The Policy intends to inculcate a Holistic approach to the student's education

based on her ability and interest and develop an integrated approach for a sustainable future of the Humanity.

Under this Policy, The SNDT Women's University, has established the **C**entre for **H**olistic **E**ducation, Training and Novel Advancements (SNDTWU-**CHETNA**).

The purpose of this is to provide a holistic education which shall help the student's growth on intellectual, social, physical, emotional, creative and spiritual levels which is in tune with every students unique expertise. It will provide with courses and programmes to connect between our past, the culture and the advancement of social and technological aspects. These programmes shall also be based on preparing the students for sustainable future.

A basket of courses ranging from a variety of fields shall be available for the students from which each student has to attempt for **2 credits** every semester (or 4 credits within 2 semester). These courses shall be termed as Add on courses and the student shall get the credits for these courses in their **ABC** (Academic Bank Credit) which they can carry forward in their educational journey.
