Brief Summary:	<p>The Department of Drawing and Painting (BVA), SMRK – BK- AK Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Nashik had organized a Talk of Dr. Sudhir Patwardhan Sir (Mumbai) on 12th March 2022 as he Was here in Nashik to take 'Godavari Gaurav Puraskar' awarded to him.</p> <p>Artist Profile: Sudhir Patwardhan considers himself a painter of people. Born in Pune, Maharashtra in 1949, he graduated in Medicine from the Armed Forces Medical College, Pune in 1972. Patwardhan, a practicing radiologist, runs a clinic in a modest part of Thane in Mumbai.</p> <p>He held his first solo exhibition of paintings in Delhi at the famous theatre personality E.Alkazi's art gallery Art Heritage in 1979. This exhibition was then held in Jehangir Art Gallery, Mumbai. Since then he has held more than 15 solo exhibitions in all major galleries, including Jehangir Art Gallery, Mumbai (1979,1984, 1989, 1994, 1999, 2002), Art Heritage, Delhi (1990), 1994 - Gallery Chemould (1994), Mumbai, Vadehra Art Gallery, Delhi (1999), Sakshi Gallery, Banglore and Mumbai (2001, 2002).</p> <p>Sudhir Patwardhan's works centres around one poetically monumental panorama of an urban and natural environment. The recent exhibition (2002) of his works at the Sakshi Gallery centred around one poetically monumental panorama of an urban and natural environment. The mostly charcoal drawings on paper were like instant notations from what happens among working-class people on city streets, otherwise more or less sketchy studies done from photographs.</p> <p>Our Principal Dr. Mrs. D.P. Despande Ma'am officially Welcomed Sudhir Sir by presenting him bouquet & shall-shrifal in her chanber. After that she briefly explained him the moto of Gokhale Education society and various activities taking place with various departments. Vice-Principal Mrs. Patil and Mrs. Bokhil Madam. H.O.D of Drawing and Painting Department Mrs. Archana Sonavane, Mr. Dwip Aher and Mrs. Bharati Hingne of Junior College were also present during this official welcome.</p> <p>After that Sudhir Patwardhan Sir, Shanta Patwardhan along with other dignitaries headed towards Drawing and Painting Department for Departmental Visit and to have a Talk with our students.</p>




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Elaborating on the thought process that goes into his work to students, he noted: "I do faces seen with a certain intimacy. Each of these, finished within an hour, gives me a feeling of satisfaction and accomplishment. From the innumerable persons encountered, a detail of an eye or a nose, or a tilt of the head has struck a cord. The note is then rapidly and vigorously expanded. During this process the emerging face has to fight against my impulse to engulf and dissolve it. The stereotype head and the remembered look of distrust are allies of otherness. With their help the face will attain certain autonomy. But it will not shake off my attachment.

"The feeling of being an intruder now catches up with me, and pulls me away from the image. I am probably fated to oscillate thus between proximity and distance. There are periods when I am neither here nor there. It is in this in-between space that figures closest to my heart take shape. Figures neither near nor farlike the distance between me and the stranger in the street or in the cafe. In such figures, close enough to be sensuously full-bodied and disquieting, but distanced through the act of observation and depiction, are compounded the pleasures and problems of both extremes. The character and social background of these figures are established and they take on a sociological role but it could as well be an autobiographical one."

Mr. Dwip Aher in his introductory speech of Sudhir Sir stated: 'His vast acrylic canvases may seem like a faithful depiction of the specific area, an ordinary and quite typical part of Mumbai with its uncomfortable symbiosis of decent residential buildings and poor ones, of industry and nature. These, however, exude a strangely bewitching atmosphere -both serene and disturbing, roughly literal and poetic in a delicate manner, which attain grandeur. Patwardhan conjures an aura of things beyond the concrete and the singular. Throughout he employs contradictory motifs and suggestions in order to make them transgress and unite in an evocation of the contemporary life cycle.'

Smt. Archana Sonavane (H.O.D) of Drawing and Painting in her valedictory speech expressed her sincere gratitude towards Sudhir Patwardhan sir for visiting Department from his busy schedule and motivating our students. She also Thanked our Respected Secretary Sir, Principal Madam, Vice-principal Madam, All Staff and students because of whom this Fine Arts Department would not have been possible and actively working as well as growing day by day.

Sudhir sir saw academic artworks displayed by First Year to Fourth Year students and praised them for their hard work.

4. Department Report of HSC Vocational of first term 21-22 was read by Coordinator Mrs Maithili Lakhe

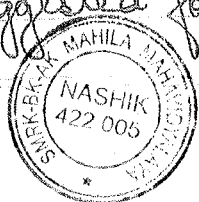
5. Enrollment of students and awareness about Vocational Education was discussed. Mr Ambrish More suggested that information of successful passed out students can be given in various ways during admission period.

Mrs Archana Kulkarni extended support for students interested in self employment by providing platform for special Bakery products.


