Deief Comment	
Brief Summary:	The <b>MITSURA</b> Art Festival, held in December 2024 at the Suyojit Grounds, showcased an inspiring theme, "War Women Water," celebrating women's resilience, strength, and achievements. Artists and creators from diverse fields came together to present unique installations and artwork addressing the festival's theme.
	Installation Theme and Concept:  Our installation was designed to narrate the remarkable journey of Sunita Williams, an astronaut and a symbol of determination and achievement. The project aimed to inspire women to dream big and take bold steps toward achieving their goals, breaking barriers and overcoming challenges. Sunita Williams' journey to space served as a powerful metaphor for perseverance, courage, and ambition.
	Installation Design:  The installation depicted a starry space-scape with hanging planets and stars, symbolizing the vastness of the universe and the limitless possibilities it holds. A life-size cutout of a young girl reaching out towards the planets embodied the dreams and aspirations of every woman aiming for greatness. The backdrop was a dark canvas speckled with a galaxy-like design to evoke the feeling of space.
	A motivational quote by Sunita Williams, "Reach for the stars with firm, and you will discover the universe within yourself," was displayed prominently to reinforce the theme of self-belief and inner strength.
	Impact and Response:  This installation became a centerpiece of the festival, drawing attention to the power of dreams and the importance of supporting women in their pursuit of greatness.
