Professor Dr. Milind Nikumbh, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Health Sciences, served as the Chief Guest and delivered a significant address. Dr. R.P. Deshpande, Chairman of the Gokhale Education Society, attended as the Guest of Honour, while Dr. Deepti Deshpande, Secretary, Treasurer & HR Director, presided over the function. Dr. Ram Kulkarni, Zonal Secretary of the Gokhale Education Society, Nashik also graced the occasion. The esteemed donors of the college Shri.
